

Who are BCA Co-Workers?

BCA Co-Workers are men and women, who are passionate about living as gospel witnesses and are prepared to make themselves available on a self-funded basis to support the ministry of regional, rural or remote mission fields. They aim to make use of their gifts for a period of time in order to grow God's Kingdom around Australia.

They can work in the local community, serve in the local church, or even coordinate programmes such as BCA's Dusty Boots or Christ for Campers.

Co-Workers seek to support ministry in areas of need. This may be by moving to a remote church where mature Christians are needed or serving in a church where membership turnover is common, to provide a stable core.

Whatever they are doing, Co-Workers are working for Christ. They are living examples of what it means to be a Christian.

Glendon and Catherine McKay had been living in Armidale but when Catherine finished her nursing degree they were looking to relocate. They moved across the country to serve in North West Australia in a small town called Kununurra alongside BCA Field Staff.

Catherine works as a nurse in the local hospital at Kununurra and both she and Glendon help out at the Bethel Youth Group for Indigenous children.



Lindsay and Lyn Whybrow moved from their home in Springwood NSW to the Central NSW town of Hillston.



In the town of around 900 people, Lindsay and Lyn participate in local activities to reach out to the community.

Lindsay works as the ministry leader at the church, providing both traditional means of outreach and annual mission events in collaboration with various well resourced churches.

Is that you?

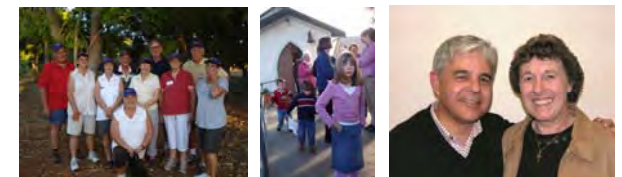
Are you able to pack up and go to be involved in church life, like Lindsay and Lyn? Or become a support for an existing ministry like Glendon and Catherine?
