How to leave a bequest to BCA

By supporting gospel ministry throughout regional, remote and rural Australia, you are making a gift that will extend beyond your lifetime.

To make a bequest to the Bush Church Aid Society of Australia, the following words should be included in your Will:

*"I give to The Bush Church Aid Society of Australia ACN 000 042 606 for its general purpose (**insert details of the sum of money, percentage or residuary of estate or description of property or asset you intend to give**) The receipt of the Society's treasurer or other proper officer shall be sufficient discharge to my executors."*

Types of gifts

There are a number of ways that you may consider leaving a gift to the work of BCA*. These are:

- A specific amount of money
- A percentage or residuary of your estate
- The whole of your estate
- A particular asset

Your gift, no matter its size, will be greatly appreciated and will serve to take the gospel to individuals around Australia.
